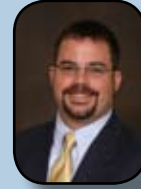

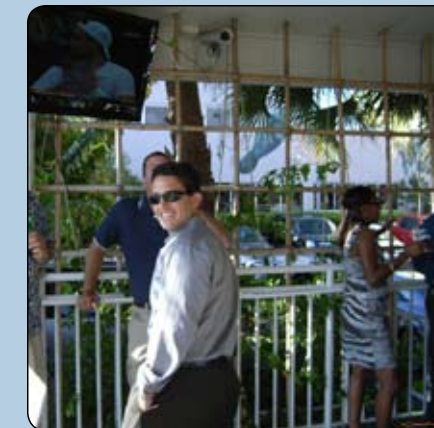

The committee also collected electronics for recycling by ARC Broward, a private, not-for-profit organization providing support and assistance to people with disabilities. It is estimated that



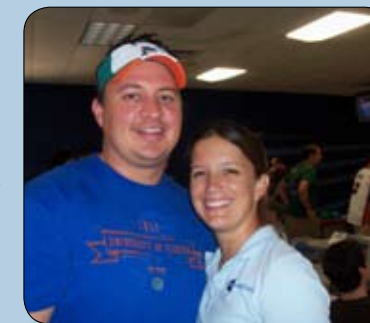

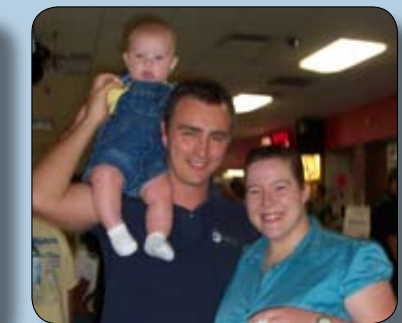
