University which was procured via construction manager at risk. We are proud of our ability to work effectively in both traditional and alternative delivery method projects. 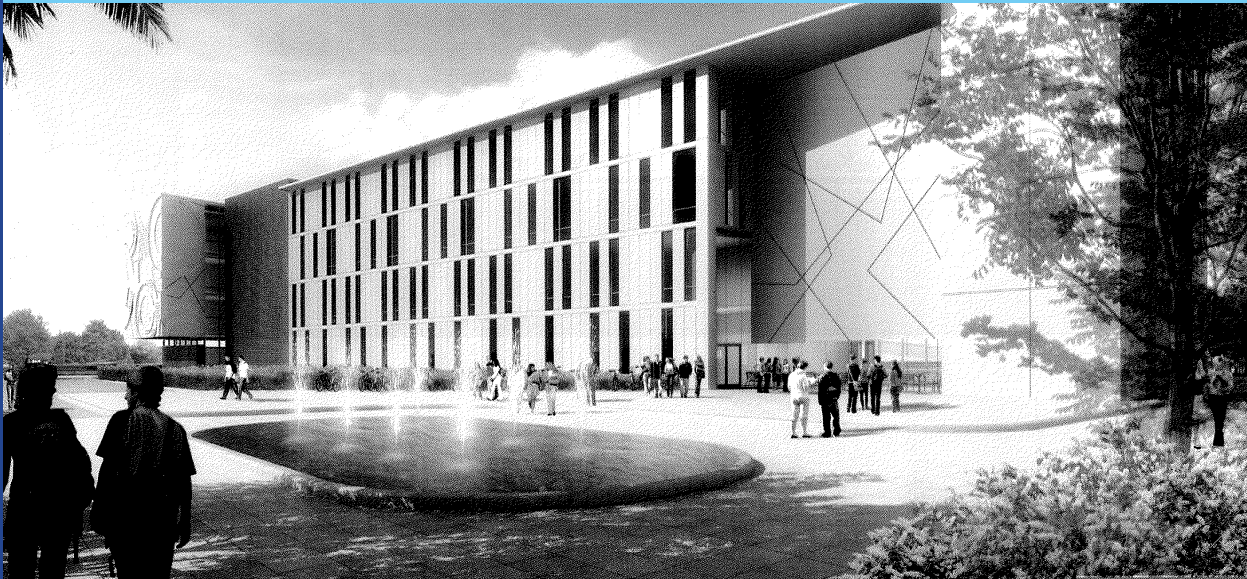

Shareholder Oscar Bello, P.E., DBIA has successfully completed the requirements for the nationally recognized Design-Build Professional™ certification. The Design-Build Institute of America (DBIA) awarded designated status to Oscar upon his successful completion of a week-long course and formal examination in all aspects of design-build project delivery. Three years substantial design-build work experience is an additional prerequisite for Designated Design-Build Professional™ certification.



The Designated Design-Build Professional™ program is intended to establish an accepted and recognized standard of design-build knowledge and experience. Individuals demonstrate an understanding of best-practices in every phase of design-build project delivery, from proposal preparation to substantial completion.



Focus on Design/Build Projects

CMA is currently working on three exciting design/build projects.

Broward College SW Center Miramar - Chen Moore and Associates, as part of the design/build team with Kaufman Lynn and

Perkins + Will, is serving as civil engineer for the overall campus infrastructure and civil engineering for the first building of the new Southwest Campus of Broward College in the City of Miramar. The project includes a master lift station for the entire master plan for the campus, off-site water main connections, and off-site stormwater culverts for future neighboring sites as required by the South Broward Drainage District. The program for the classroom/administration building includes science classrooms, administration, and classroom/shared space for Florida International University. The project will be permitted through the City of Miramar, South Broward Drainage District, Broward County and South Florida Water Management District.

FCAA Cudjoe Regional Wastewater Collection - CMA, as part of the design/build team with Layne Heavy Civil Inc., is designing the sanitary



sewer collection system that will convey sewage from these keys to a transmission force main and/or master lift station located along US1/Overseas Highway.

The final design will be a conveyance system that will combine various wastewater collection system technologies in order to connect as many on-site wastewater systems as possible for the lowest overall cost.

Key West Public Transportation Facility - Chen Moore and Associates is responsible for the planning, design, permitting, design/build package preparation and overseeing construction for the City of Key West Department of Transportation Public Transportation Facility. The new facility serves as the transportation operations and administration building for the City of Key West and the primary terminal/transfer station for lower keys shuttle bus service, which serves Marathon to Key West. It provides parking for public transportation customers and employees.

Chen Moore and Associates' Annual Picnic was held at Tradewinds Park in Coconut Creek on March 30, 2013. The afternoon was a great opportunity for our Fort Lauderdale, Miami, West Palm Beach, Gainesville and Stuart employees to get to socialize and celebrate a successful first quarter of 2013.
