HISTORY

- Fred Wilson (1921-2002) founded Fred Wilson & Associates in Jacksonville, FL.
- 1962** Frank Wilson II left the State Road Department to join the firm.
Became one of the first consulting firms to design projects for the State Road Department (which became FDOT in 1969).
- 1966** William “Ed” Wilson, Sr. (1927-1995) joins the firm adding Electrical Engineering services.
- 1986** Won a major FDOT project for the Acosta Bridge Replacement as Design Lead.
- 1991** Began Electric Utility Design for Reedy Creek Improvement District, which led to similar work at other electric utilities in Florida and Georgia.
- 1992** Began major Electrical Engineering work for NASA at Kennedy Space Center in Merritt Island, FL.
- 1999** Won a major design project for Power Transmission and Distribution Systems with JEA (formerly Jacksonville Electric Authority).
- 2004** Won our first Georgia Transmission contract for Power Transmission and Substations.
- 2007** Won our first Georgia Power contract for Substation Design.
- 2009** Won a major contract with a large private electric utility in Florida.
- 2016** Won our first Solar Electrical Design project.
- 2021** Acquired by Chen Moore and Associates, Inc. and becomes FW&A, a CMA company
