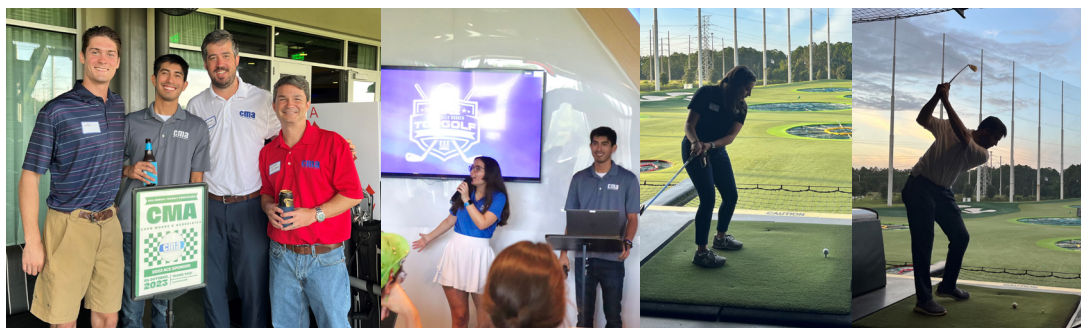
International Coastal Cleanup
