HOPE South Florida

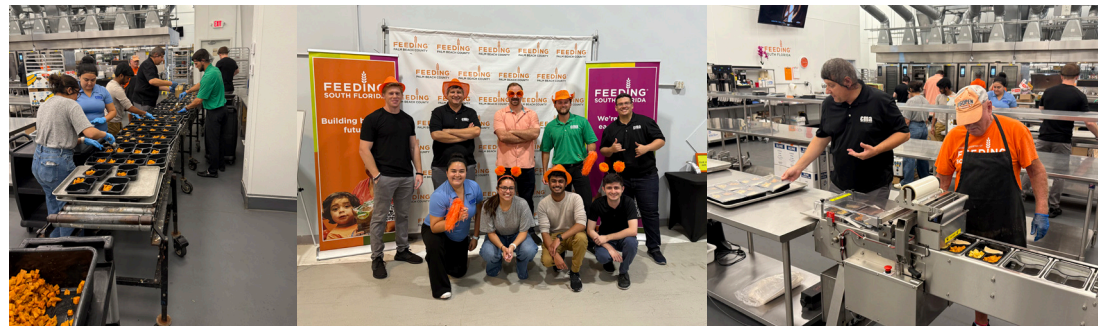
